PRODUCT GUIDANCE SHEET

BRAKES DESCALER



A powerful commercial phosphoric acid descaling fluid with corrosion inhibitors and wetting agents designed to safely remove the heaviest build-up of lime scale from inside dish and glass washers, tea urns, floors and other surfaces where lime scale is prevalent.

HOW TO USE

It must be diluted correctly with water to prepare effective cleaning solutions. Product is dispensed via a standard 5lt pelican pump. **N.B. The use of warm water will accelerate the effectiveness of Descaler.**

Dish & Glass Washers:

- Switch off the electronic wall mounted dosing equipment.
- Depending on the capacity of machine dilute at 1:20 parts water ratio and pour directly into the wash tank.
- Heat water to working temperature and circulate until lime scale is dissolved.
- Ensure the rinse and wash jets are free of lime scale to optimise machine cleaning performance.
- Agitate with a scouring pad to remove stubborn heavy scale deposits.
- Drain solution, refill and rinse thoroughly with clean water.

Tea Urns/Catering Water Boilers:

- Fill with water and add up to 10 plunges of a 5lt pelican pump.
- Allow approximately 1 hour for the product to dissolve the lime scale.
- Drain and rinse thoroughly with clean water.

Surface Descaling:

Add 1 plunge of a 5lt pelican pump to a 750ml labelled trigger spray bottle.
